To Whom It May Concern:

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) proposes to widen I-26 from SC 27 (Exit 187) near Ridgeville on the western terminus to approximately 1.0 mile west of Jedburg Road/S-8-16 (Exit 194) near Summerville on the eastern terminus at MM 193. The project study area will extend approximately one (1) mile along SC 27 in each direction from I-26 to provide for potential interchange improvements and widening at Exit 187. The project includes the following elements: adding a travel lane in each direction of I-26 toward the existing median, median clearing and cable guardrail installation, improving the Exit 187 interchange and ramps, replacing the I-26 mainline dual bridges over Cypress Swamp, potential replacement of Cypress Campground Road bridge over I-26 and drainage improvements. The proposed improvements will seek to reduce congestion, improve traffic operations, and increase capacity along this stretch of the interstate.

The project's scope of work is divided into multiple phases due to the unknown impacts of the corridor improvements based on multiple design alternatives. The following services will be performed during this first phase of work: surveys, traffic studies, National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation, and preliminary roadway/bridge design.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of this project and to solicit any additional information that you may have related to the potential social, economic, and environmental impacts of the proposed project on the area. SCDOT, in consultation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), are preparing an Environmental Assessment (EA) to evaluate the benefits and impacts from the proposed project, in accordance with NEPA and implementing regulations.

As part of project development, preliminary data and information has been collected in support of the EA. A review of the available mapping, including the National Wetland Inventory (NWI), aerial photography, and topographic mapping indicates the presence of streams and wetlands within the project corridor. Additional field work and coordination with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) will be conducted to further identify and confirm the jurisdictional status of all wetlands and other waters of the U.S. along the project.

In accordance with Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, a Natural Resource Technical Memorandum (NRTM) will be prepared for the project and will include a database search and field survey for federally protected species. The current projected species list for Berkeley County includes six endangered species and four threatened species. Dorchester County lists the same

endangered and threatened species except for the Frosted flatwoods salamander and the Northern long-eared bat. Coordination with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and South Carolina Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR) under Section 7 of the ESA will take place to confirm the status of the protected species and their habitat. The NRTM will document the methods and findings associated with this evaluation.

A noise analysis will also be conducted for the proposed improvements to predict future noise levels in accordance with the SCDOT Traffic Noise Abatement Policy. The noise analysis will model individual noise receptors, potential sensitive receptors within the project corridor, and will measure and model existing noise levels and predicted future noise levels. In addition, a cultural resources survey will be completed along the project study area and coordinated with the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO).

As an integral part of the environmental process, SCDOT is soliciting input from agencies and individuals regarding the various potential impacts of the proposed project. To ensure that issues of the proposed project are fully evaluated, SCDOT requests your written response concerning any beneficial or adverse impacts of the project relating to the interest of your agency. SCDOT looks forward to receiving your comments on the project within 30 days of the receipt of this letter. Comments should be addressed to:


